

Waste Management WILL pick up the following household garbage items:

- Food waste
- Dead animals
- All containers of food and food products (glass, metal, plastic or paper)
- Broken dishes, glass, chinaware and flatware
- Paper products
- Furniture, mattresses – One (1) item per week maximum.
- Cooking utensils, empty paint cans
- **Household appliances (Freon must be removed properly from all refrigerators, air Conditions and all other related appliances.)**
- **Carpeting**, or similar items, rolled and tied, cut to lengths of four feet, less than one foot in diameter – limited to 2 rolls per week.
- **Grass clippings, brush, leaves, yard and garden refuse** (in plastic bags or trash cans).
Twigs and branches must be less than one inch in diameter and be tied in bundles less than four feet in length and eighteen inches in diameter.

Bundles of garbage must be less than 40 pounds per container (not including furniture, household appliances, hot water heaters and refrigerators.)

Christmas Trees will be accepted in December, January and February only, and must be cut to six feet or less. Christmas trees do not have to be bundled.

Waste Management WILL NOT accept the following items:

- **Construction materials resulting from alterations and construction of buildings.**
i.e. – wood, 2x4's, shingles, plaster, drywall, etc.
- * Stones, dirt and sand
- * Broken concrete
- * Automobile parts, including tires and lead acid batteries
- * Concrete wash tubs, oil base paint, flammable liquids, metal 55 gallon drums and grease drums
- Pianos, organs spas, hot tubs or water softeners

Hard to recycle Items:

We are often asked at the Bellevue Borough offices how to dispose of special items such as household and automotive wastes, and electronics such as TV's and other items.

Currently all residents who are on our Bellevue Borough garbage service are eligible to arrange for disposal and pick-up of automotive waste, electronics (including TVs) by calling Waste Management at 1-800-449-7587 or by contacting them via their web-site at:

Recycling – Recyclable materials are limited to clear, green and amber class, aluminum cans, bi-metallic cans, PET and HDPE plastics (codes 1 & 2) and newsprint. Newsprint must be bundled and separated from other recyclables.
