

STREET BANNER SPECIFICATIONS

Banners must meet the following specifications in order to be installed over Borough streets.

Solid Banners:

- Banner must be no longer than 25 feet and no wider than 3 feet.
- Banner must be provided with half- circle slits cut into the banner to reduce fluttering.
- Top and bottom ropes for hanging shall be provided with the banner and shall be no less than ¼ inch diameter and 10 feet longer than the width of the street, but in no event less than 75 feet each.
- Top rope shall be stitched to the banner to prevent movement.
- Bottom rope shall be free to move back & forth to ensure centering of the banner.



Individual Letter Banners:

- Banner shall be no more than 1 row high with a maximum height of 3 feet and a maximum length of 40 feet.
- Top and bottom ropes for hanging shall be provided with the banner and shall be no less than ¼ inch diameter and 10 feet longer than the width of the street, but in no event less than 75 feet each.
- Top rope shall be stitched to the banner to prevent movement.
- Bottom rope shall be free to move back & forth to ensure centering of the banner.
